

QO Code of Conduct for Participants

The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect for each other, be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the membership secretary or any member of the club committee.

As members of QO we ask you to:

- compete within the rules and respect officials (planners, controllers and organisers) and their decisions.
- respect other competitors and encourage fair play
- pay any fees for training or events promptly
- keep to agreed timings for training and competitions
- wear suitable clothes for training and competitions and bring your own orienteering equipment (compass, whistle etc) to sessions. NB the club coaches will be able to lend some equipment to beginners.
