From next year it will be mandatory for anyone taking the role of planner, organiser or controller to have had attended an event safety workshop, no matter how experienced they are.

At this workshop we will discuss the safety issues surrounding our events, and what planners, organisers and controllers can do about them. Specifically we will look at how to plan acceptably safe courses, how to organise with safety in mind, how to deal with emergencies and what the rules and guidelines say. Hopefully by the end we will all be more confident about how to go about setting up a safe event, and our events will be better managed as a result.

This is a 3 hour workshop, definitely not a lecture, and you are encouraged to come and share your opinions and experiences. It is entirely a classroom theory session - no outdoor activity is involved.
