# Final Details

Landowners have asked us to impose some strict out of bounds and biosecurity rules. So while we have done our best, unfortunately we have not quite got the event we originally intended. However, please observe these rules to make sure we can continue to use the Quantocks in the future.

**Location:** Car parking will be on forest roads at OS grid reference ST 182 378 (postcode TA5 1HN). From the parking there is a 1.5km walk up hill to registration and the start, mostly along narrow roads. **Young children must be supervised.** We suggest you take everything you need for the day with you to the start - there will be a tent at the start to leave bags and you can leave car keys with registration.

Alternatively, you may use the lay-by at grid reference 174 385 to drop off passengers from where it is only 300m walk along the road to registration, but there is no parking for competitors here.

**Start times:** From 10:00 until 13:00. Courses close at 15:00.

**Entry fees:** Seniors £10 (£8 for members) Junior £3.  
Families taking part as individuals £16 (£14 for members).  
Families taking part as a single group on a junior course £6.  
No charge for parking.

**Courses:** Unfortunately we are unable to provide a white course.  
The following courses will be on offer:

There are road crossings on the blue and brown courses only

**Toilets:** Will be provided both at the parking site and at registration

**Dogs:** Are welcome, but please take care on the roads

**Biosecurity:** To reduce the risk of spreading diseases such as Ash Dieback and Sudden Oak Death, please use the disinfectant wash provided to clean your shoes before you leave, and please ensure your shoes and clothing are washed and dry for a minimum of 48 hours before you wear them in any other woodland.
