

## **QO Code of Conduct for Club Officials and Volunteers**

QO officials and volunteers will:

- promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. exercise, fair play and respect for the countryside).
- display consistently high standards of behaviour
- follow guidelines laid down by British Orienteering and the club
- never condone bad behaviour or the use of prohibited substances.

In addition all those organising events and activities will:

- make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part.
- consider the well-being and safety of participants.

All those coaching juniors will:

- develop an appropriate working relationship with juniors who take part in club activities, based on mutual trust and respect.
- hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover.
- work to the sports coach UK Code of Conduct.
