Explanation of Change

Membership -- a few membership payments have been received from BOF -- £44. Most 2023-24 membership payments will be received from BOF in January/February 2024.

Events -- no change in the overall event situation, year to date showing a £(270) deficit.

The three 2023-24 QOFL events to date have generated an initial surplus of about £1,000 but this was offset by the purchase of 3-year OCAD Team mapping software licences.

BOF and SWOA levy payments have been made to date, including Great Bear QOFL.

(JOG's and Coaching/Training are registered as activities and no levy payments made.)

The final event surplus, excluding OCAD licences, will be about £600 after payment of Forestry England land access fees. At present, FE invoicing is up to six months after an event/activity.

Development -- expense of £(356), coaches expenses to date for the present training/coaching series and village hall hire.

Clothing -- £27, ongoing sales from existing stock.

Equipment - £(186), primarily purchase of replacement SI control box (£105) and SI spares.

Other -- £145, BOF affiliation fee £80 and miscellaneous expenses.
