Explanation of Change

Membership -- membership payments are starting to be received from BOF -- £178. Most 2023-24 membership payments should be reived from BOF by the end of February 2024.

Events -- a significant change in the event situation since the prior status.

The positive change is due to a Credit Deposit payment from Racesignup (£943) where QO members make one payment to cover future entry fees -- this saves QO credit card fees charged by Racesignup. BOF and SWOA levy payments have been made to date and from January 1st JOG's are registered as events and levies are paid.

Event income has further been boosted by payment from the Oak Partnership schools for the maze activities organised by Phil Sewell (£150).

Development -- expense of £(358), coaches expenses to date for the present training/coaching series partially offset by fees received (shown under training revenue).

Clothing -- £25, ongoing sales from existing stock.

Equipment - £(9), negligible spending in this period.

Other -- £114, primarily a donation from Friends of Long Run Meadow.
