2	Matters Arising –	
	Process of obtaining maps – Steve will make the inventory public.	
3	Events and Activities Past events: Spunch events – Ollie reported that the Spunch events were successful and we had new orienteers as a result. Andy Thornton has brand control and would like remuneration – an amount per entrant perhaps paid at the end of the season – we will look at this in the finance section and make a decision. Ollie happy to continue as organiser for next summer.  QO participation in Croeso – great event. It is a real shame that we did not, as a club, put something on our website about how many of us took part, how much it is was enjoyed, the social element and how successful QO members were. We have agreed that in future we will try to get a person to write up something for each of the days and submit, hopefully with photos, to Phil for adding to website.  JOG – Ray reported that JOG is continuing well with the first two events having had 60 competitors (32 at the first and 28 at the second). Biggest course take up being the fox. Devon families have been coming along. Also, holding informal get togethers.  Plans for future events: JOG series – Aiming to hold 10 JOGs over 2 terms. Have the volunteers in place for first time, need volunteers for the second. Informal events for family get togethers in between to keep momentum. Set up a WhatsApp group for these informal events. The informal events are registered as an activity with BOF to ensure insurance cover.  SW League & QOFLs. The programme has been set and we have organisers and planners for all events. However, we are in need of controllers. Steve and Richard will work through the list to hopefully get this sorted. Sheila and Ray have requested that, where possible, our QOFLs have a white (hare) course to help with JOG continuity.  Street series Autumn / Winter 24/25 – Alasdair has emailed Richard – Alasdair is happy to continuing with the street series and has drawn up a list of events.  Alasdair has maprun administration rights. The committee has agreed to make Ray an administrator to assist with his JOG coordinator/organiser status.

	<ul> <li>Dartmoor Challenge – in progress.</li> <li>Club Champs – Sheila planning, Pete controlling, Andy has done what he can and is handing over to Stodge to do SI for the event. All in hand with permissions. Have we got the events room for this event?</li> <li>Compass Sport Cup - Regional Round – Permissions, Officials, etc – need permission for the deer park to the north to ensure that we have the quality area required for CSC.</li> <li>Urban - Bridgwater SEOUL - Event status, Permissions, Officials, Car Parking, etc. The issue with permissions at the school has not been resolved as yet. The school has deferred to the sports centre and we are still waiting on decision.</li> <li>Ramscombe/Great Wood CATI – Timing, Officials – It was agreed to hold the event in late summer 2025 just before term time. Needs a lot of advertising, encourage families (QO has had a large drop off in family membership).</li> <li>Email received from Rosie - there is no requirement to impose the 2/3 events and you are out rule as there is a levy to cover insurance.</li> <li>There is a levy paid for non-members, but all are insured. It appears there is no longer a need to keep a count of how many times non-members attend. Richard has asked Miffy to confirm.</li> </ul>

Present resources include – BOF, our website, chatsite, Facebook page (Alasdair is admin), there is a Strava group and various WhatsApp groups. We need to look at setting up a newsletter. Can we look at having an accessible table showing our event entry fees on the website. At present, we have to search. Can we also ensure that detailed information about our events is got to Phil earlier. It was agreed that we need someone to actively push Facebook, we need to reach out to bring in new members. We would need to ensure that we give clear guidance as to what our focus is. Ray and Sheila will ask around. Perhaps offer an incentive. 	<ul> <li>a. Financial status thru end September – see attached report.</li> <li>b. Ramscombe POC &amp; HPC Grant status Back in 2019, Steve applied for a grant from Hinkley Point to cover the following – re-map of Great Wood, re-map of the Bridgwater Urban area, the creation of the Ramscombe POC and the holding of CATI event. Initial bid request rejected. Re-submitted to show a benefit to the surrounding community and we were awarded a grant of £3600. Covid then happened. The Great Wood mapping was done by Dave Peel. Bridgwater urban map purchased from Gavin Clegg and updated and extended by Jim Mallinson. Steve had to obtain quotes and invoices from preferred suppliers with regards the POC. Materials to be used for posts as per FE constraints. No response received, despite chase ups. However, Steve finally received prices and a response from the FE design team. But no further forward. Steve then booked a video call with the Hinkley grant administrator and the money was received in the QO bank last Thursday. Big thanks to Steve for persevering.</li> </ul>	Steve
