In summary

- Sorted through equipment and provided repair where appropriate.
- Located items in their designated containers and places.
- Identified missing equipment, tracked it down and repatriated it.
- Made some improvements to the designated locations of various items.
- Made improvements to location labelling.

Recommended purchases:

For Registration, Download, 1st Aid use etc. There is currently
only 1 serviceable Khyman tent but it has a suspect frame that
has been repaired. There is a shelter and a (heavy) tunnel tent
which we have not seen used but would not be appropriate for
Quantock winter weather.
Some research indicates many tents now having inflatable
hoops rather than poles but in strong winds poles will be better.
The Khyam ScreenHub is the follow-on model to our ScreenHouse- and is currently on offer at £420 each from RRP of £720.
These to act as missing Finish and Clear boxes for the Maze.
This to replace the old phone and card reader. Ray has tried out
the new iZettle app (as suggested) but concludes Sumup is
simpler and more appropriate for infrequent users. This can
currently be bought for a one-off cost of £59 against RRP of £79.
To provide portable battery backup to mobile payment device.
Cost circa £20.
Lightweight folding chairs that collapse to carry in a bag over
your shoulder.
Large ball of string for miscellaneous use.
Large roll of tape for Starts, Maze and route marking.

Other recommendations:

- Print and laminate a batch of Yellow and White smiley face signs, to hang on stakes, for use at QOFLs.
- Update the Inventory spreadsheet and photographic location guide to hang in equipment store.

Other:

We scrapped the Khyman tent that was badly ripped and suggest scrapping the following unless anyone objects: 2 x narrow metal stands (unsure of intended use), an old whiteboard with carpet on the back and 2 x old folding chairs (ex-Devon).
