Some notes on the event and results:

- The results are in the order they came out from the SI timing software, juniors first, then the seniors- your final position is shown on the far right. Congratulations to the overall winners on the two courses.
- The final position is a calculation based on your snooker score results, minus any penalties applied for being late back (serves you right!) plus a bonus if you managed to clear the tablethis was then modified according to the BOF handicapping factors for age and sex.
- Two juniors, Oli and Erin, and only one senior, the other Oli all managed to clear the table on their courses- well done to you all- a bonus of 100 points is added to your base score.
- Most people got the scoring format correct- if you didn't, your score reflects this- I hope you enjoyed it anyway.
- My apologies for the printing quality of the event maps- on the test print, the colours of the
 balls stood out clearly, but not on the final ones printed. The brown ball (141) was not
 clearly distinguishable from the reds colour and a few people clearly punched it by mistake (I
 hope) thinking it was a red ball- I have credited these people concerned with the 10 points
 the ball would score if it was indeed a red.
- Many people were confused by the mobile controls shown on the map- the two with legs! It seems a lot of people confused the mobile pink ball and searched in vain for it at the location it was shown on the map- it was of course walking around the park in Rosie's pocket. Bizarrely, there were no such issues with the mobile black ball next time I'll keep the mobile balls off the printed map!
- There were two static controls 171 on the ground- one for each of the junior and adult courses to avoid any road crossing s for the juniors- the adults that found and punched an 'extra' 171 (black) control not shown on their map (actual number 172) may be disappointed to see it scored them zero- as it was not on their course!
